IN THIS CRAZY COVID WORLD!

At the Bulls, it is super important to us to keep both our players and families, and those coming to us from other Associations, safe and well whilst visiting our facilities. Ours is a small, one court facility, so in some instances we have had to be super careful, and we trust that you understand and appreciate the reasons for this. Please find below our current covid protocols and restrictions which reflect a COME, PLAY and GO policy. We would ask for your cooperation and support of the below protocols, so we can all continue to play Basketball for as long as possible in this crazy covid world! Many thanks!

Please find below our protocols as at August 20, 2020.

ENTRY PROCESSES

If you have flu like symptoms, have been unwell, are awaiting covid testing results, have travelled interstate or have been to any of the covid hotspots, we ask that you do not enter the stadium and advise your coach immediately. Entry is through the main RED front door. Before entry you will be asked to scan a QR code to record your details, and retain the receipt to show our Court Supervisor when entering the stadium. On entry, you will be asked the current covid screening questions, and will have your temperature checked. If any of the questions indicate a risk, or your temperature is recorded over 37.5 degrees, you unfortunately will not be permitted entry into the stadium. Upon entry, you will be asked you use hand sanitiser, and follow all of the normal protocols of good hygiene and social distancing.

SPECTATORS

We are currently allowing NO spectators into our Stadium for either SPRING LEAGUE or representative games. We know . . . we hate it too!!

PLAYER DRESS AND EQUIPMENT

We ask that players come dressed ready to play, and do not bring bags or any additional equipment into the stadium. If anything is brought, it will need to be left unattended outside. Teams are asked to bring one ball only for warm ups (two for rep teams), and this will be sanitised prior to entry. Players will be asked to use hand sanitiser when subbing in and out, and at all time outs.

PERMITTED NUMBERS

Each team is can have the following people to enter the stadium with them:

Players: Spring League: Maximum of 10 players/Junior Reps: Maximum of 10 players/Senior Reps: Maximum of 12 players
Coaching Staff: 1 Head Coach/1 Assistant Coach (Reps only)/1 Manager
Score bench: Spring League: 1 scorer/Reps: 2 scorers (Please note all scorers must wear masks whilst they are on the bench)

TIMING

Spring League - please arrive 15 minutes prior to your games, and you will be allowed onto the court 5 minutes before tip off
Junior Reps - please arrive 20 minutes prior to your games, and you will be allowed onto to the court 10 minutes prior to tip off
Senior Reps - please arrive 30 minutes prior to your games, and you will be allowed onto to the court 20 minutes prior to tip off

FACILITIES

Change rooms and the canteen will be closed. There will be limited availability to fill water bottles.

EXIT

We ask that all players and spectators leave the facility directly after the game, via the GLASS doors near the canteen at the northern end of the courts (court supervisors and referees will assist)

Our court supervisors and referees are working really hard to keep our players and families safe, and abide by the covid policies in place. Please offer them every assistance and support as they do this. Unfortunately if this is not the case, you will either not be permitted to enter, or asked to leave the stadium . . . and we do not want to do this! The court supervisors are running the show, so please work with them!!

The above policy will be updated on a weekly basis each Wednesday, in line with current conditions.
